



- •Ensures accountability and reduces corruption




Challenges Faced by LGUs in Achieving Good Governance





CY 2010 to 2012







2022 SEAL OF GOOD LOCAL GOVERNANCE (SGLG) INCENTIVE FUND







The SGLG Incentive Fund evolved from one of the long-standing flagship programs of the Department which was the Performance Challenge Fund (PCF). Originally established in 2010, the program serves as a performance-based reform program of the DILG that seeks to rationalize intergovernmental

transfers of the National Government to Local Government Units (LGUs) and encourage the convergence of local development initiatives with national development agenda and priorities.




The Seal of Good Local Governance (SGLG) Incentive Fund was institutionalized by the virtue of Republic Act No. 11292, otherwise known as the Seal of Good Local Governance Act of 2019.

Linking SGLG Results to Intervention Packages

The national government agencies shall use SGLG assessment results as reference, whenever appropriate, in identifying beneficiaries of performance-based incentives and other capacity development program.



The Seal of Good Local Governance for Barangay (SGLGB) is performance assessment and recognition system designed distinguish barangays with outstanding various performance across governance areas. It also intends to barangays to encourage continuously progress in delivering efficient, equitable and quality public puts primacy services. 
CORE GOVERNANCE AREAS

These are the foundational indicators that ensure good governance particularly in delivering essential public services. They assess the effectiveness of key programs and projects in terms of financial bility, peace and order, and protection of life and property.

ESSENTIAL GOVERNANCE AREAS

These indicators encompass providing basic social welfare services, promoting business and income-generating activities, and safeguarding the environment.

ASSESSMENT CRITERIA

The principle "3+1" applies, where a barangay needs to pass ALL of the three (3) Core Governance Areas, AND at least ONE (1) of the Essential Governance Areas
