

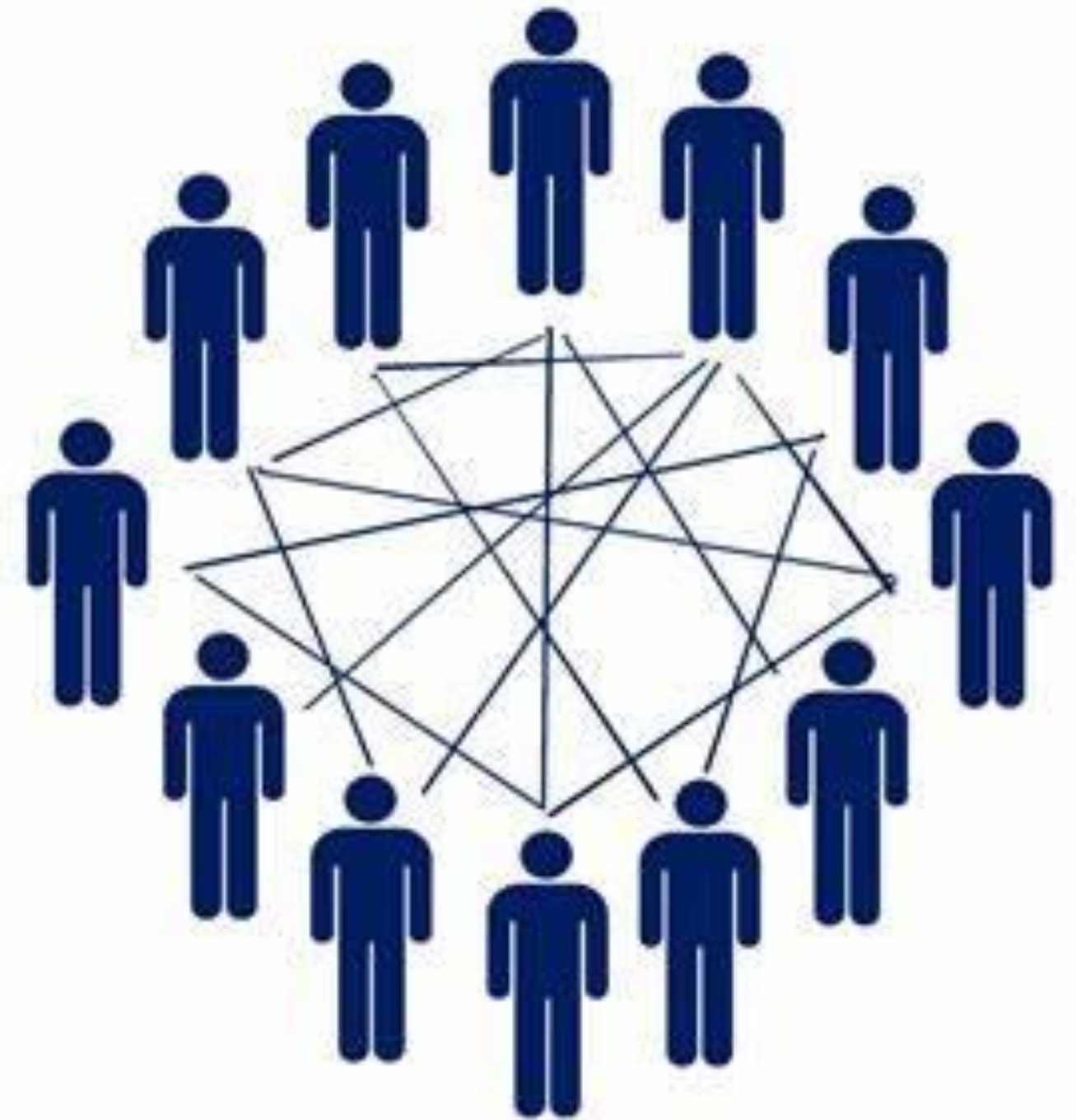

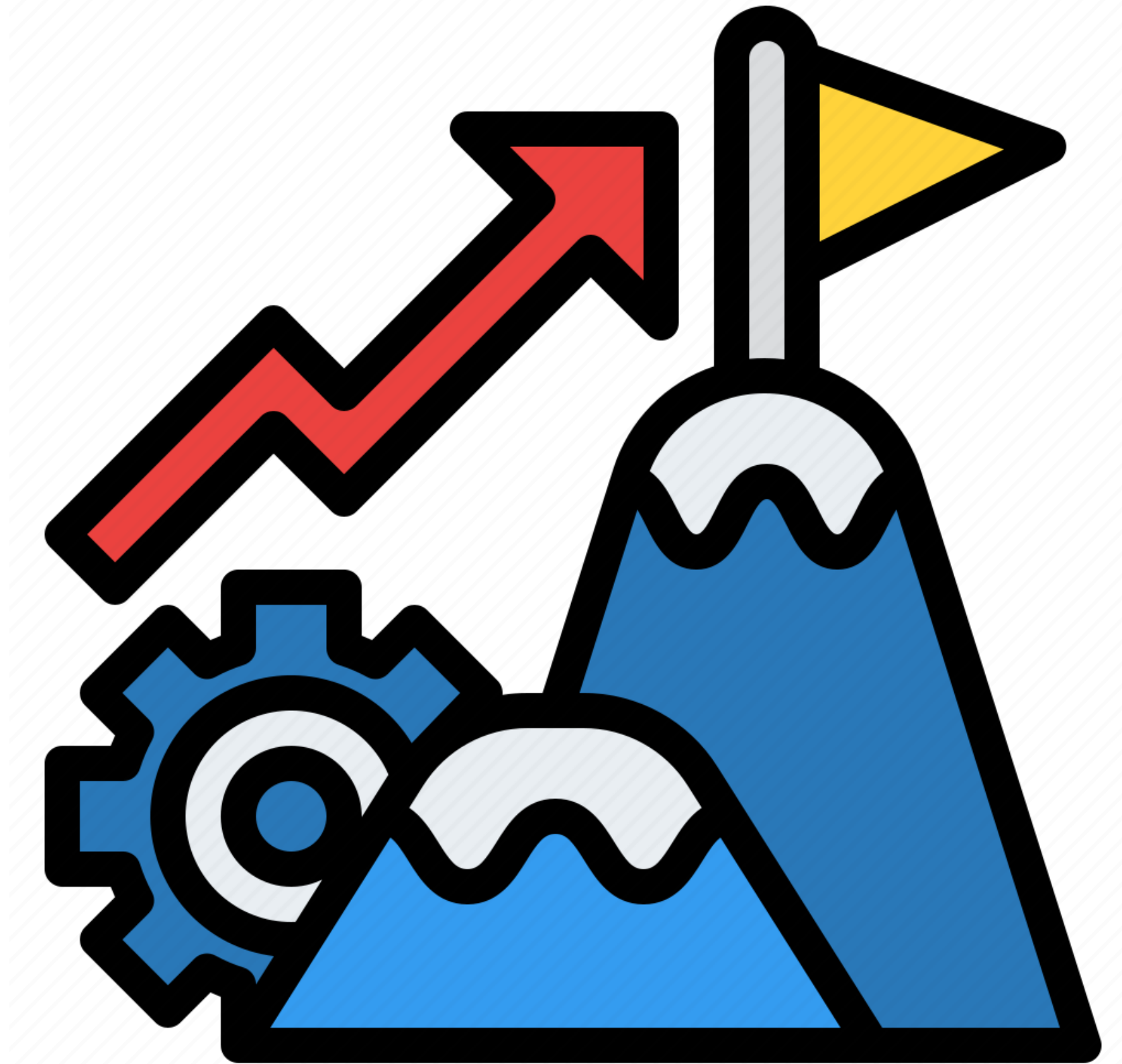
Why is Good Governance Important for LGUs?

Challenges Faced by LGUs in Achieving Good Governance

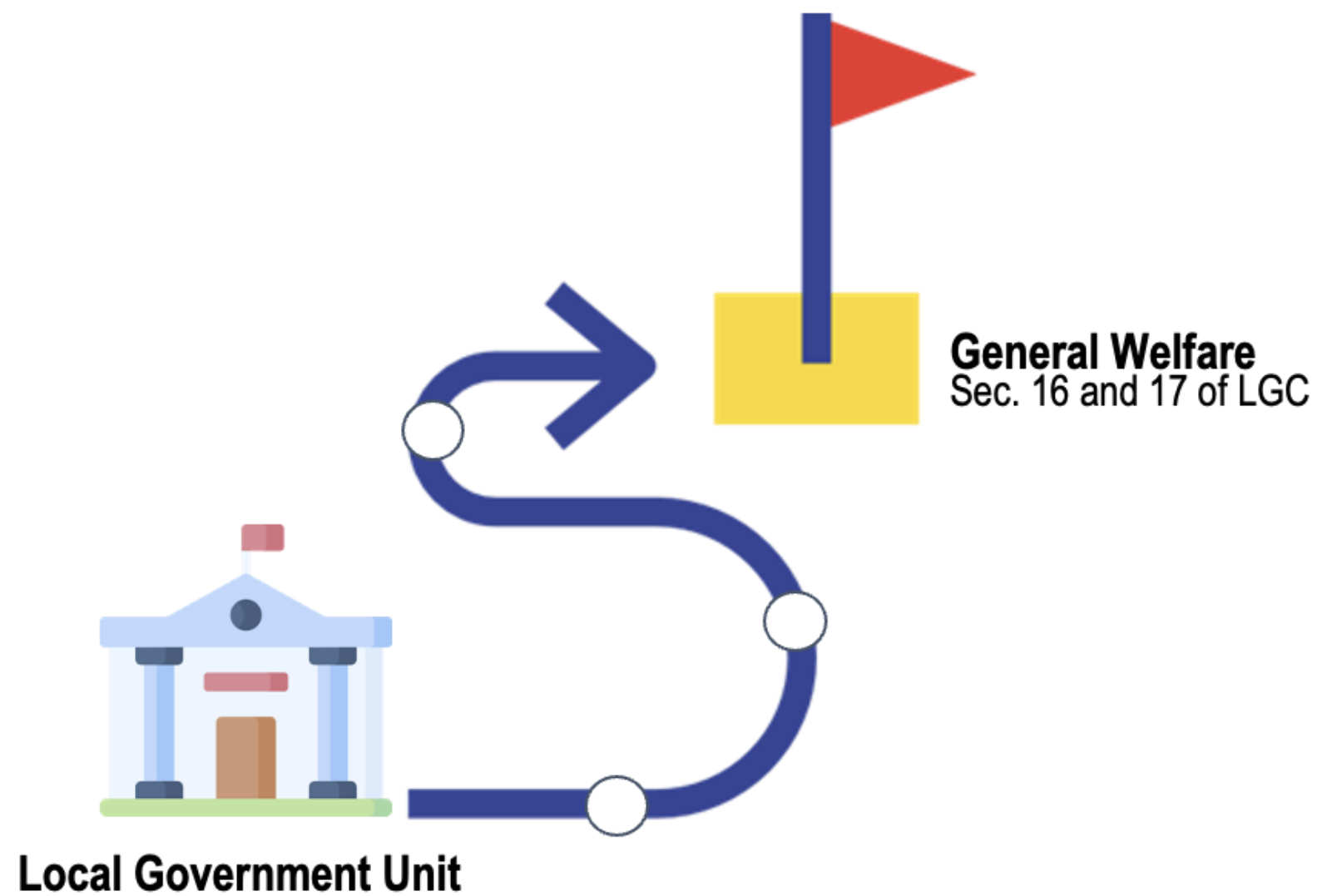
- Limited resources and capacity.

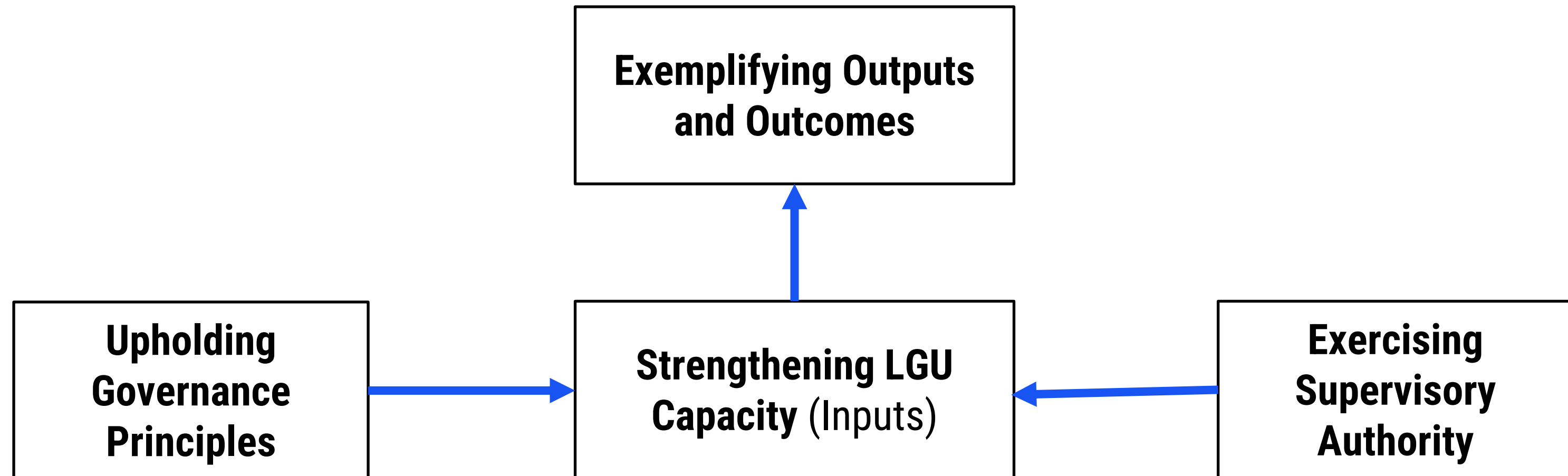

CY 2010 to 2012



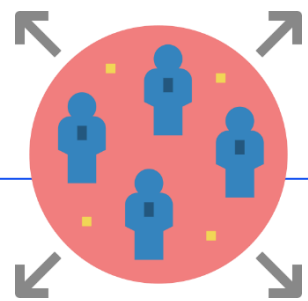

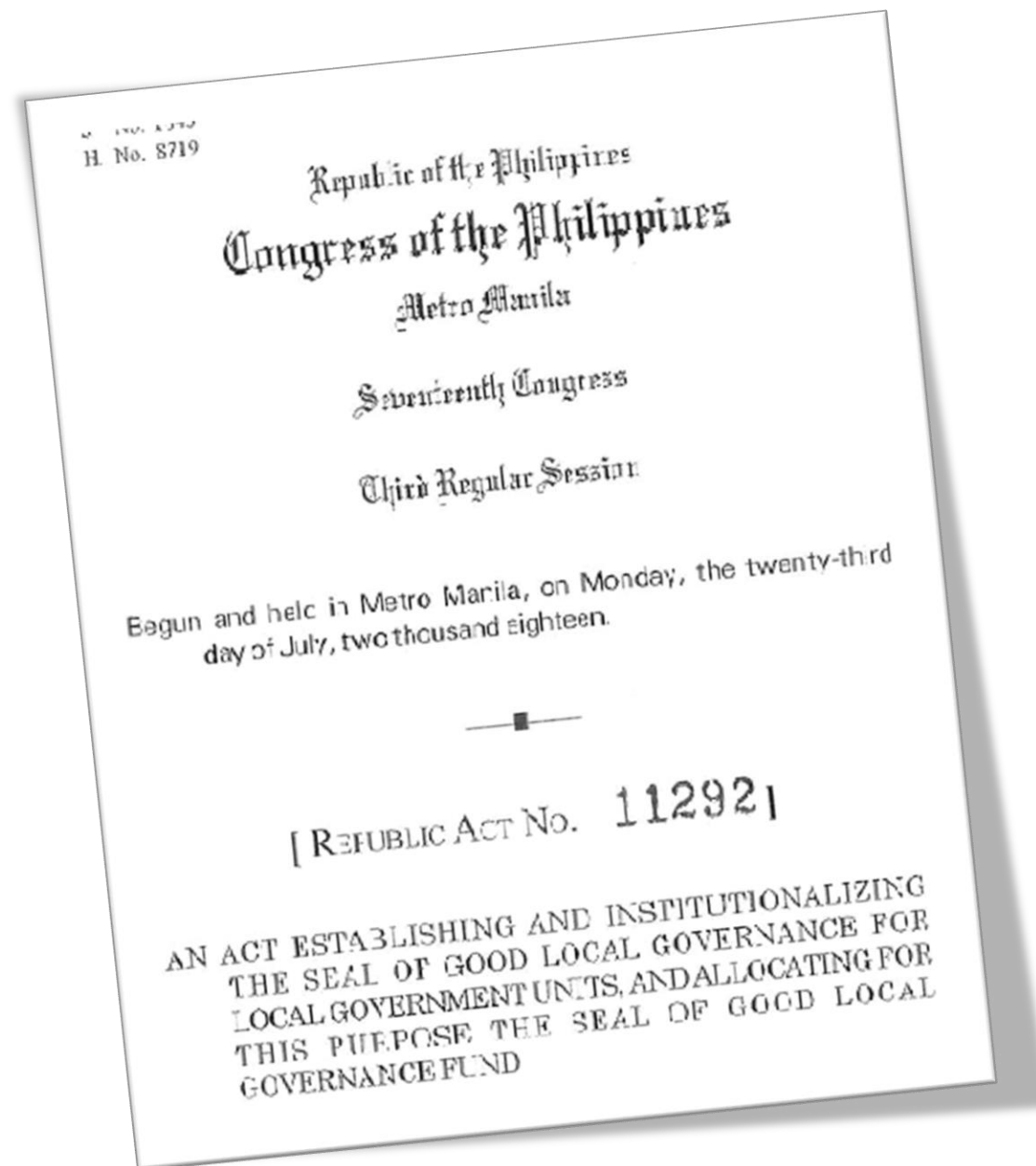
Supervisory Function

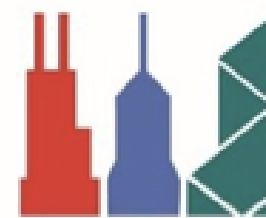

2022 SEAL OF GOOD LOCAL GOVERNANCE (SGLG) INCENTIVE FUND



Background



The SGLG Incentive Fund evolved from one of the long-standing flagship programs of the Department which was the Performance Challenge Fund (PCF). Originally established in 2010, the program serves as a performance-based reform program of the DILG that seeks to rationalize intergovernmental

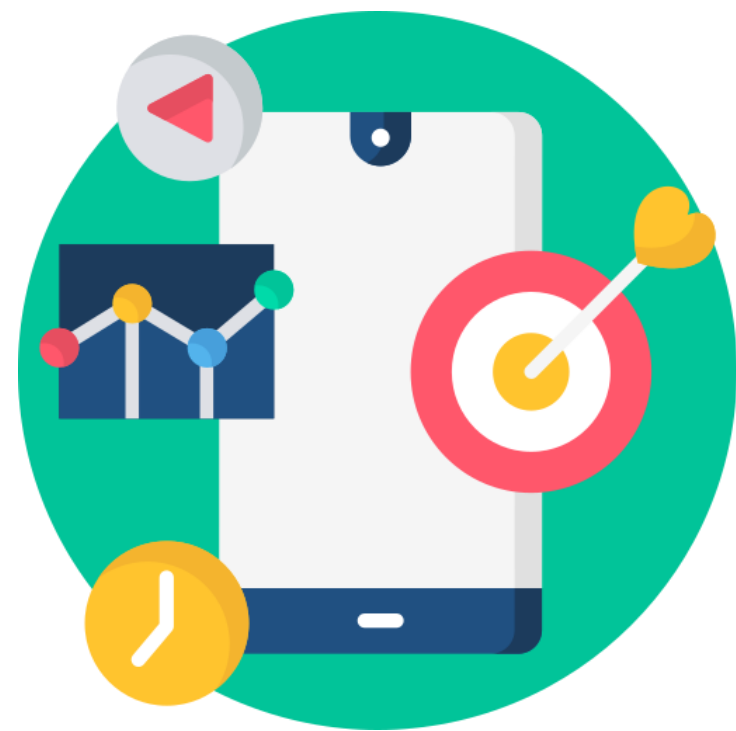
transfers of the National Government to Local Government Units (LGUs) and encourage the convergence of local development initiatives with national development agenda and priorities.

Legal Basis

The Seal of Good Local Governance (SGLG) Incentive Fund was institutionalized by the virtue of Republic Act No. 11292, otherwise known as the Seal of Good Local Governance Act of 2019.

Linking SGLG Results to Intervention Packages

The national government agencies shall **use SGLG assessment results as reference**, whenever appropriate, in identifying beneficiaries of performance-based incentives and other capacity development program.



The Seal of Good Local Governance for Barangay (SGLGB) is a performance assessment and recognition system designed to distinguish barangays with outstanding performance across various governance areas. It also intends to encourage barangays to continuously progress in delivering efficient, equitable and quality public services. It puts primacy to integrity and good performance as pillars of meaningful local autonomy and development.

CORE GOVERNANCE AREAS

These are the foundational indicators that ensure good governance particularly in delivering essential public services. They assess the effectiveness of key programs and projects in terms of accountability, peace and order, and protection of life and property.

ESSENTIAL GOVERNANCE AREAS

These indicators encompass providing basic social welfare services, promoting business and income-generating activities, and safeguarding the environment.





COVERAGE

ALL barangays nationwide that shall participate in the SGLGB assessment

ASSESSMENT CRITERIA

The principle “**3+1**” applies, where a barangay needs to pass **ALL** of the three (3) **Core** Governance Areas, **AND** at least **ONE** (1) of the **Essential** Governance Areas



The Impact of Performance Assessment on Local Governance

- **Enhancing Performance:** Encourages LGUs to improve systems and processes.
- **Promoting Transparency:** Increased public trust due to regular assessments.
- **Rewarding Excellence:** LGUs excelling in SGLG standards receive recognition.
